The LS-20 is a fun, affordable and versatile keelboat. It's lightweight with a lifting keel which makes it easily launched and hauled from the trailer for convenient dry-sailing. For round-the-buoys racing or relaxed daysailing, the LS-20 is the ideal small-sized sailboat built with care and precision for performance and durability.

The LS-20 has a provisional Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF) rating of 132. Sailing centers and yacht clubs are encouraged to contact The Landing School regarding fleet pricing. Each boat is sold with Seldén carbon spar; Maine Sailing Partners main, jib and asymmetrical spinnaker; Harken and Lewmar hardware; all high-quality standing and running rigging; plus a one-year manufacturer's warranty.
